



Mission: Newton Performing Arts Center (NPAC) opened its doors in 2004 and expanded into the current location at the Chisholm Trail Center in 2008. NPAC is founded on the belief that a well-rounded experience that includes the arts is an important part of every child's growth and development. NPAC's growth has included a scholarship and reduced fee program that has allowed many students the opportunity to experience the art of dance. NPAC offers performance opportunities such as competitions, recitals, concerts, and festivals for all students to share their love of dance with the community.

Sessions: Our dance year consists of two sessions, a school year session running September through May and a summer session in June & July. Our annual recital is held at the conclusion of our school year session in early June.

Tuition: An annual enrollment fee of \$20 per student (\$35 for family) is due at the time of registration. Tuition is due by the 10th of the month. Statements will be handed out each month for unpaid balances after the 15th and a late fee of \$15 will be charged. Any tuition that remains unpaid after the 30th of the month will may result in the student being removed from class. Students will not be allowed to return to class until payment is received in full.

Recital: An end of the year recital will be held the weekend after Memorial Day, **June 3rd & 4th, 2023**. Each student will be charged one recital fee for each class they are enrolled in. If a student is in multiple classes, then it is a good idea to start paying early. All recital fees will be due on or before January 7th, 2023. Recital fees are \$65 per class and will include a costume and a pair of tights. More information will be available about recital in the months to come.

Dress Code: Loose baggy fitting and jean clothing is not acceptable for safety reasons in all classes except hip hop. Girls are required to have their hair pulled back and out of their faces for all classes. No jewelry is allowed to be worn in class with the exception of small earrings.

Ballet- Must wear a leotard and tights, can wear leggings or tight shorts, pink ballet shoes
Jazz- Leotard or tank top, leggings, jazz pants, capris, or shorts, Tan jazz shoes
Tap- Leotard or tank top, leggings, jazz pants, capris, or shorts, black tap shoes
Irish- Leotard or tank top, leggings, jazz pants, capris, or shorts, black jazz and tap shoes
Modern- Must wear a leotard, with tights, leggings, jazz pants, capris, or shorts, no shoes
Acro- Leotard and shorts or capris, no socks or shoes
Hip Hop- Any clothing that stretches or is loose fitting, clean tennis shoes
Broadway Bound- Leotard or tank top, leggings, jazz pants, capris, or shorts, black jazz shoes
Pre-Dance- Leotard and tights, skirt, shorts, or leggings, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes
Tiny Tots & Broadway Babies- Leotard and tights, skirts, shorts, or leggings, pink ballet shoes
Boys- t-shirt, tank, shorts, sweat pants, joggers, appropriate dance shoes for class
