

Make up is necessary to avoid a washed-out look under the bright stage lights. Please use the following directions as a guide. (For more information, please refer to the "Makeup Application Instructions' on page 5)

- 1. Use an All-Day Lipstick (dark red).
- 2. Use Base & Powder to match skin tone.
- 3. Eye Shadow (Neutral shades) Use base color over lid, then darker in the crease.
- 4. Eyeliner (Black/brown) Use on upper lid only.
- 5. Mascara (black) parental discretion (not required if there are sensory concerns)

For safety purposes, ABSOLUTELY NO JEWELRY PERMITTED (unless a part of the costume).



Dress Rehearsal for Recital is Friday May 31st.

MANDATORY FOR ALL DANCERS.

This rehearsal is closed to the public.

Dress Rehearsal is in full make-up, hair, costume, tights, and dance shoes. See the chart beginning on page 9 below for specific arrival times for classes.



Each class will be taking a group photo on stage at Dress Rehearsal on Friday May 31st. The class photos will be included with your Individual Pictures.

After the photo, we will block and practice each dance. If it is your last dance, then you are free to go after and if you have further dances please change into your next costume.

Students will be allowed to watch in the auditorium during dress rehearsal.

Recital is not a meal time, but if your child needs a snack, please be sure to pack CLEAN healthy snacks and drinks for your little dancer. Water only please while in costume. Do not send colored drinks or bottles that do not completely seal.

NO messy, sticky, or crumbly snacks. No Popcorn.



PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING!

Help make sure your dancer has cleaned up their changing area and has all of their belongings. We are not responsible for any lost items.

When you receive your costumes (week of May 6th) take them out of bags and try them on. Do any necessary alterations and steam if needed. Carefully cut out any tags that show.

Recital tee-shirts – Hanes Comfort Colors Tee in Crimson. Adult sizes have a pocket detail on the front with a graphic. Child sizes do not have a pocket, but do have the graphic on the front as well.

Recital – Makeup Application Instructions & Example Colors

(It does not have to be these exact brands/colors)



FACE FOUNDATION

Use to match skin tone. Use at parent's discretion



EYES

E.L.F Bite-Size eyeshadow "Cream & Sugar"



EYELINER/MASCARA (black/brown)

Use at parent's discretion. Mascara and eyeliner help best to open the eyes on stage. We suggest a TRAVEL SIZE mascara, the wand will be easier to use with small eyes.



BLUSH

A shade or two darker than everyday color



LIPSE.L.F SRSLY Satin Lipstick

Two things we hear a lot from parents regarding recital makeup:

"Why does she need to wear so much makeup for the recital? She's too young." "How do I do dance recital makeup? I don't even wear makeup myself."

- a) **Those super cute shiny costumes look stunning on stage!** And they will completely overshadow your dancer's beautiful smile and facial expression if we don't apply enough makeup.
- b) The stage lights are very intense and make a dancer's face look washed out. Properly applied makeup will enhance your dancer's features under bright, colorful stage lights.
- c) The dancers are elevated on a stage and are very far away from the audience. This makes the facial features disappear and your dance will look less lively and joyful on stage.

Recital – Hair Instructions (for high/low bun)



Step 1

Using the hairbrush or comb, brush the hair back into a ponytail. Apply hairspray or gel to tame wisps and strands of hair that are not long enough to reach the ponytail. Then secure the ponytail with an elastic hair tie that matches the dancer's hair color. Depending on the dance & if there is a hat or headpiece, you could make the bun down on the neck, middle of the head or higher.



Step 2

Twist (or braid) the ponytail and put in pins. Start twisting the hair and put it around the center making a tight circle. Then secure the twist with the bobby pins or hairpins by putting them as many as you need. To do this, open the pin and then make sure the pin grabs part of the hair from the twist and goes straight in the head. If the dancer feels a constant pain when the pin is applied remove it and put it again until there is no pain. If you have a lot of hair you can divide the pony tale in two parts and twist them apart. Put one twist around first with pins and then the other twist. Depending on your hair if is thin or thicker you will like to use the bobby pins to grab bumps and thin hairs and the hairpins for thicker parts. Use lots of hair pins!



Step 3

Put on a hairnet that matches the student's hair color. Wrap the hair net around the bun to catch loose hairs. With a few twists the net should be tight on the bun and you can put some pins to secure it. You can also insert more pins around the bun to re-shape or secure loose



Step 4

Use hair spray or gel to secure back hair around the face or any loose strands. Secure any pin in style hair piece (flowers, appliques, barrettes) on the **right** side of the dancer's bun. Use lots of pins!



Recital FAQ

"Do I need to change my dancer in between dances?"

No, parents can remain in the audience. We will have parent volunteers and staff members helping with supervision and changing in the dressing rooms.

"When my dancer is done with all of their dances, can they watch the rest of the recital in the audience"?

Because this is a ticketed event with limited seating, we cannot allow dancers in the audience during show unless they have a ticket or can sit on a lap. <u>Also, ALL DANCERS are welcome to be present for the finale bow at the end of the show.</u> Dancers may sit in the auditorium and watch during Dress Rehearsal.

"What are some things I should bring for the day?"

In this packet, we've provided you a check-list for reference of items that may help ease the stresses of the day. Not all items will apply to all dancers so we ask you to use discretion with the items listed.

"Can I take pictures and video?"

Pictures may be taken as long as the flash is turned off. Video is not allowed. Please be courteous of those in the rows behind you when taking pictures during performances.

ABSOLUTELY NO PHOTOS OR VIDEOS IN THE DRESSING ROOMS!

"What should I bring for the big day?"

- All costumes, tights, and shoes, hair accessories and small props (if applicable)
- Makeup for touch ups
- Extra bobby pins/hairspray/hairnets/hair ties (that match hair color)
- Water bottle
- Hairbrush/comb
- CLEAN, no-mess snacks
- Cover up for costume when eating/drinking
- Mini sewing kit/safety pins (you never know!)
- Stain stick
- First aid kit
- Deodorant (if applicable)
- Flipflops/flats for walking around before or after
- Double check that all nail polish has been removed!
- Coloring books/small games for in between dances (if needed)
- PROPER UNDERGARMENTS! No regular underwear under tights. Only tight fitting skin tone undergarments are acceptable.
